Purpose of the Position:

The purpose of this position is to make a significant contribution to the delivery of technology projects within Council. The incumbent will work alongside the Solutions Architect and the project team to deliver on the approved technology projects.

You will be responsible for developing and improving an ASP.NET front-end user interface and APIs for both the Assessment and Accreditation Hubs, ensuring integration with other systems, and facilitating user testing and training.

You will also be responsible for developing new process requirements and process improvements.

This role calls for analytical and solutions-orientated thinking and working with a project team responsible for providing a relevant and robust technology solution for the Council.

Key Deliverables of the Position:

- Work with the project team to identify shortcomings of the current system, user requirements, and the most efficient and effective technology solution for the Assessment and Accreditation functions of the Council
- Develop a front-end user interface and technology workflows
- Perform testing with the appropriate staff and remediate issues uncovered by testing
- Work with the project team to explore and improve system functionalities and work processes if required.
- Build security and privacy features within the new system, according to the privacy policy, the cyber security policy and the technical requirements for the systems
- Deployment of solutions to users and key stakeholders
- Training staff in the use of the new systems and assisting with documentation
- Support the General Manager Technology in post-deployment tasks and technical support
