### About the Australian Physiotherapy Council

The Australian Physiotherapy Council (the Council) is the accreditation authority for physiotherapy in Australia. We accredit education providers in Australia and internationally to deliver physiotherapy programs, and we assess internationally qualified physiotherapists seeking registration and employment in Australia.

The Council's purpose, "Ensuring tomorrow's physiotherapy workforce", is delivered through high-quality, independent accreditation and assessment, supported by a committed and values-driven organisation.

### About the role

The Council is seeking expressions of interest for one independent (non-Director) committee member to join its Audit and Risk Committee (ARC).

The ARC is a Board Committee that supports the Board by overseeing:

- Financial reporting, including budgets, accounting policies, application of standards and the annual financial report
- Governance, internal controls and risk management, including insurance, cybersecurity, business continuity, WHS, compliance, fraud prevention and conflict-of-interest matters
- External audit, including appointment and oversight of the external auditor, audit scope and review of audit findings
- Investments, including monitoring performance, asset allocation, Investment Manager appointments and updates to the Investment Policy

### The ideal candidate

The successful candidate will be an experienced senior professional with strong financial acumen and risk management experience, able to exercise independent judgement and provide constructive challenge in a Board Committee environment. Candidates will be assessed on these core capabilities, together with relevant skills and experience across the areas listed below. While not all are required, a combination of experience across multiple areas will be highly regarded:

- Audit and assurance
- Investment strategy and portfolio management
- Knowledge of the National Registration and Accreditation Scheme
- Strategy development, implementation and measurement
- Corporate and commercial law
- IT governance and cybersecurity
- Digital transformation (including AI)
- Governance experience as a director or board committee member
- C-suite executive experience (e.g., CEO, CFO, CLO, CTO, COO or equivalent)
- Crisis management
